AIMSweb results are coming home. AIMSweb results indicate that 48% of 1st grade students are at benchmark in reading and 78% in math.

Kindergarten has 65% of their students at benchmark in reading and 65% in math. **Good job, keep up the good work!** Our goal is to have 100% of the students at benchmark by the end of the school year. This can be accomplished if we all work together.
