The district goal is that every child will be reading at or above grade level by the end of third grade. The first assessments to determine reading levels have been completed. These scores allow teachers to address the strengths and weaknesses of each child through whole group and small flexible group instruction. We will continue to monitor each child throughout the school year ensuring that adequate progress is made. Please make sure your child arrives to school on time. If at all possible, we are asking that you schedule necessary appointments for times other than the reading block time. Please work with your child to read at least 15 minutes each evening. 
