**2011-12 SCHOOL CANCELLATION & SNOW ROUTE POLICY**

In case of cancellation of school, early dismissal of school, or running snow routes due to hazardous road conditions, extremely cold temperatures, or failure of heating equipment, Sullivan School District will utilize the AlertNow Notification System. With AlertNow, you will be contacted by phone with a recorded message concerning cancellations. An AlertNow call will display a phone number of 573-860-7669. Please make every effort to keep your contact information current. You can contact the building your child attends to make sure your contact information is updated. The District will also announce on the following media:

If possible, the district will run a **snow route** as follows:

The below-listed buses will run their normal route on snow days.

- **Bus # 1: Will not travel Shady Lane.**
- **Bus # 3: Will not travel into Sherwood Forest Subdivision**
- **Bus # 4: Will not go to Meramec Caverns. Will not travel on Papin, Birch, Meramec or Stanton Acres- These students will meet or be dropped off at the Stanton Post Office.**
- **Bus #6: Will not travel Old Sappington Bridge Road, Rock Road or Farris Road.**
- **Bus #11: Will not travel Hwy K and will only go to Indian Creek on Hwy A.**
- **Bus #15: Will not travel Sleepy Hollow or Hamilton Hollow.**

The school district requests your support in the following:

1. Please see that your child is dressed warmly. Gloves and hats are a MUST.
2. Make sure your child knows exactly where to go if school is dismissed early (home as usual, to a friend's, to a babysitter's, etc.).
3. Make sure your contact information is always kept current.
4. Do NOT assume that because road conditions are good, school will be held. School could also be closed due to extremely low temperatures or a breakdown in heating equipment.
